**JUDGMENT OF CONVICTION AND SENTENCING ORDER**

The State appears by DPA Patrick Dowd. The Defendant appears at liberty and with his attorney, Robert LaBre, for sentencing. Sentencing hearing held.

The Court unconditionally accepts the plea agreement, finds the Defendant guilty, and enters judgment of conviction on Count II – Stalking, a Level 6 Felony. Per the parties’ plea agreement, the remaining counts and Cause No. 71D08-2306-F5-000219 are now dismissed.

The Court, having considered I. C. 35-38-1-7.1 and argument of counsel, makes a sentencing statement. The Court sentences the Defendant to the custody of the St. Joseph County Jail for 30 months. The Court suspends 18 months and places the Defendant on probation for 18 months. The Defendant has 7 days Class A credit for time served prior to sentencing.

The Court provides the Defendant a written copy of the Conditions of Probation, and orally advises him of the terms contained therein. The Defendant shall report to the Adult Probation Department within 48 hours of his release from custody.


The Court, in accordance with I.C. 35-38-1-7.7, having heard evidence at trial, or based on a factual basis provided as part of a guilty plea in this case now finds that the Defendant has committed a crime of domestic violence, as defined by I.C. 35-31.5-2-78. The Court files, separately, the Domestic Violence Determination.

The Defendant is assessed court costs and a \$50 Domestic Violence fee. The Defendant shall provide a DNA sample as required by Ind. Code 10-13-6-10.

The No Contact Order shall remain in effect as a term of the sentence but is modified to allow for communication to effectuate parenting time arrangements.

An evidentiary hearing is set for December 11, 2023, at 11:00 a.m. on the issue of restitution.
